20 March Request from Theresa May for Article 50 extension

Without *Withdrawal Agreement's* approval by the House of Commons, Brexit is delayed until 12 April 2019

2 April 2nd Brexit extension

Granted until 31 October 2019

19 October Boris Johnson's new Brexit deal loses in the Commons

3rd Brexit extension request

28-29 October 3rd Brexit extension accepted by EU until 31 January 2020

UK Parliament votes in favour of an early general election

12-13 December UK election results

Landslide victory for the Conservatives with 364 seats
